Play Beat The Pro

Add another dimension to your game. Compete against a touring pro, instead of par, and have a legitimate chance to beat him. All this through the *Conditional Match Play Handicap System™*.

My purpose in developing the Beat the Pro concept is to make you feel better about your game. Not many of us can look at the ordinary (scratch) score card and delight in our progress, even when we play near our full potential.

The combination of comparing your per hole score against a high scoring tour pro, instead of par, using a handicap system that rewards you when you play up to your potential, can't help making you feel better about your game.

Additionally, thanks to the computer, you can track your attainable success against the pro, which (some might say) legitimizes your claim to fame, and you can even brag about it globally.

My fervent hope is that you have fun with the process and you continue to participate for as long as it gives you pleasure.

Picking The Pro

A tour pro with a high score in a given tournament is your competition. Because you'll be playing a different course than the pro, a literal per hole designation must be used. The key for this is as follows: E = Eagle, I = Birdies, P = Par, O = Bogies, D = Double Bogies, T = Triple Bogies, Etc. See below, how your pro competitor scored on the course he played in his tournament.

Keeping Track of the Competition

I keep track of your success by issuing you fame points. If you beat the pro, you gain 1/2 fame point. If you come in second, you gain 1/4 fame point. You need 9-11/2 fame points to be inducted into the *Page Of Fame*.
